Treasurer Report

February Profit & Loss Statement

Financials were presented to Board members on March 9th and are summarized below. The February Year to date P&L is \$3.8k favorable to year to date budget goals with Income \$1.6k favorable to budget and Expenses \$2.2k favorable to budget.

Reasons for Variance

YEAR TO DATE INCOME is \$1.6k Favorable to Budget: \$0.7k favorable Rented Docks; \$0.5k favorable Oyster Roast; \$0.4k favorable clubhouse rentals.

YEAR TO DATE EXPENSE is \$2.2k Favorable to Budget: \$2.5k favorable Maintenance spending; \$0.8k favorable for Race Committee, Commodore, and Administration supplies; offset by \$1.1k unfavorable electric.

E Dock Rebuild

\$50,000 Down Payment to Floating Docks: The initial \$50,000 payment was made February 18, 2015 with the contract signing

Final Payment to Floating Docks due upon successful installation of the Dock This payment will be made with our unsecured bank loan from First Bank of Georgia and have 3 years to complete payments; and, we are hopeful to pay this loan off early and there are no fees for early payoff.

Annual Board Review of Member Special Purpose Equipment Storage

Required Annual Board Approval for Power Boat and Special Purpose Equipment. As required in H&G Rule 30.13, annually during the First Quarter, the Treasurer and Yard Master must present the Board with a listing of all power boats and special purpose equipment stored on ASC grounds with the expectation these will be re approved. There were 5 member power boats and 3 special purpose units approved

Inventory of Dry Storage Lot

All Storage Slots confirmed: An audit of our storage lot documented a few recurring problems –Missing member numbers, Low or flat tires, and unauthorized storage. Members were notified and are correcting these issues.

ASC C-15's: We have two donated C-15 boats with no anticipated use. We should attempt a sale or disposal.
